Throughout the weekend, Charles will guide you through the technical aspects of photography, as well as various artistic/ creative techniques that allow you to craft expressive, poetic images. Topics focused on impressionistic techniques include: how to use your camera as a "paintbrush;" in-camera multiple-exposure techniques (including his "Multiple-Exposure Monet" technique, which he invented); soft-glow montage; composite montage; long-exposure techniques; alternative post-processing options; and various apps to accomplish the same using nothing more than your smartphone.

Charles will also focus on creative macro photography. He will share tips and techniques for capturing artistic floral close-ups, suggested equipment and accessories unique to macro, effective lighting techniques, mastering artistic compositions and learning how to see abstracts.

Through slide-illustrated lectures, field demos, 1-on-1 instruction, and supportive group image evaluations, join Charles to add a new level of creativity to your photographic work!


